The therapy has tremendous clinical application. It has been demonstrated as safer simpler, effective alternative to the costly sophisticated orthotopic liver transplantation. There is heavy mortality rate in cases suffering from acute and chronic liver failure; orthotopic liver transplantation is the only available treatment to improve the survival rate.
