Abstract:

Dr. Kew has devoted the past 32 years to researching hepatocelluar carcinoma, one of the major malignant diseases in the world today and either the most common cancer or among the three most common cancers in many of the most populous regions of the world, including sub-Sahran Africa.

In so doing, he has made significant contributions to our understanding of the aetiology and pathogenesis, clinical presentation, diagnosis, and pathobiology of this tumour, as well its epidemiology and that of its risk factors, not only in Africa but throughout the world. His research findings have contributed in large part to persuading the South African government to introduce measures directed at preventing this common and devastating tumour.
